

Education One, LLC Board Minutes – Regular Meeting

1. Welcome & Introductions

Indiana Achievement Academy – Based on the lack of school board oversight for IAA and Education One's concerns regarding the management of school finances and overall financial viability, Chuck Nedele moved that we close Indiana Achievement Academy, effective June 30, 2015. Lynn Brooks seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Career Academy South Bend

CASB – Lindsay reported that the public hearing for Career Academy South Bend Network Schools, including the primary, middle, and high school, which was held on June 4, 2015, went very well. Information that was shared at the public hearing was presented to the board.

Chuck Nedele moved that Education One approve Career Academy South Bend High School (9-12), Career Academy South Bend Middle School (5-8), and Success Academy South Bend Primary School (K-4) for a period of 5 years, beginning June 30, 2015. Mike Bock seconded the motion. Lynn Brooks abstained from voting. The motion carried.
