	Graduation rates are determined by analyzing cohort numbers of teacher candidates who were accepted into the EPP's Professional Education Sequence and tracking those cohort numbers through graduation.  The EPP's Professional Education Sequence is an internal benchmark where teacher candidates must demonstrate:  • EPP-determined ACT, SAT, and or Praxis Core test performance  • At least a 3.0/4.0 cumulative GPA  • A clean criminal background check  • A successful EPP Professional Education Sequence application													
	Typically, teacher candidates complete the requirements of the Professional Education Sequence in late sophomore or early junior year. For graduation rates, the EPP identified the number of teacher candidates in cohorts from the academic year who have completed the Professional Education Sequence and then tracked their status upon completion or exit from the University.
