Requirements

- Completion of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution with an overall GPA 3.0 or higher and no grade lower than a C for prerequisite courses
- Two letters of recommendation
- · Completion of the GRE within the last five years.
- Discernment into the profession, such as health care experience/ patient contact
- Prerequisite coursework taken at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university or equivalent

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At its 2023M meeting, the Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant, Inc. (ARC-PA) placed the Trine University Master of Physician Assistant Studies Program sponsored by Trine University on Accreditation-Probation status until its next review in 2025M.

Probation accreditation is a temporary accreditation status initially of not less than two years. However, that period may be extended by the ARC-PA for up to an additional two years if the ARC-PA finds that the program is making substantial progress toward meeting all applicable standards but requires additional time to come into full compliance. Probation accreditation status is granted, at the sole discretion of the ARC-PA, when a program holding an accreditation status of Accreditation Provisional or Accreditation - Continued does not, in the judgment of the ARC-PA, meet the Standards or when the capability of

the program to provide an acceptable educational experience for its students is threatened. Once placed on probation, a program that fails to comply with accreditation requirements in a timely manner, as specified by the ARC-PA, may be scheduled for a focused site visit and is subject to having its accreditation withdrawn.
