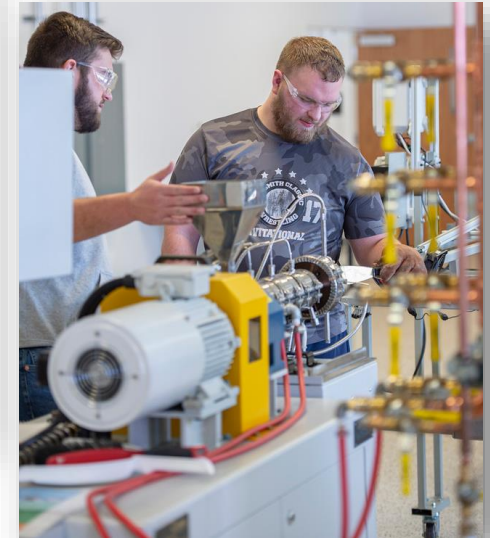
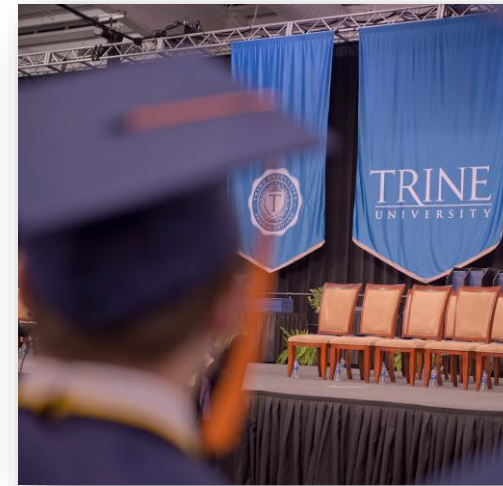

## Trine Dual Enrollment Options:

### Academic Experience

- Concurrent enrollment model
- Courses are taught in the HS setting with the certified HS Dual Enrollment teacher
- \$25 per credit hour

### Online Experience

- Courses are taught online by Trine's professors through our Learning Management System (LMS) Moodle
- Courses are generally taught in 8 week Terms
- \$50 per credit hour

### Online Discount

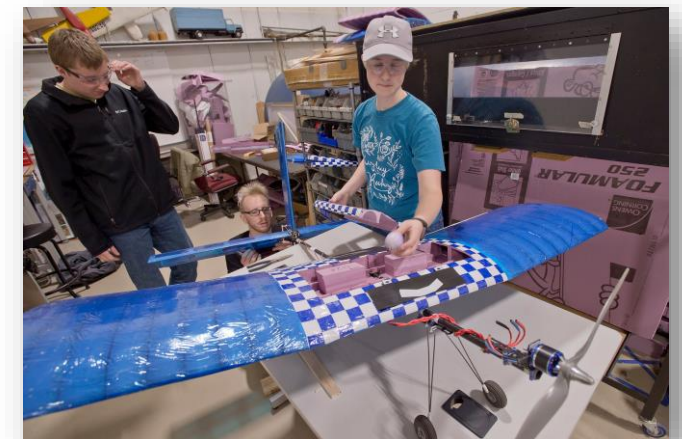
- Courses are taught online by Trine's professors through the LMS, Moodle
- Course size is over 20 per class
- \$33 per credit hour

### Campus

- Courses are taught here on our beautiful and state of the art campus
- \$95 per credit hour

### Guided Experience\*

- Pilot Program
- Co-teaching courses taught primarily through online as well as with a facilitating teacher in the school

## Dual Enrollment Academic Calendar

- Important Dates
- Be aware of these for the upcoming school year
  - **Fall/Spring Breaks**
    - Keep in mind these breaks differ between your local school and Trine
  - **Dropping a Course**
    - There are 2 of these each semester (more for online)
      - One for a full refund and one for no refund
      - Be aware that if you wait too long to drop a course you may not get the full or any refund
  - **Unpaid Bills**
    - October 31<sup>st</sup> and March 29<sup>th</sup>
    - Students who have yet to pay their bill will be dropped from their course
    - Caution: This means they will earn a W for the course
      - It will end up on their permanent transcript



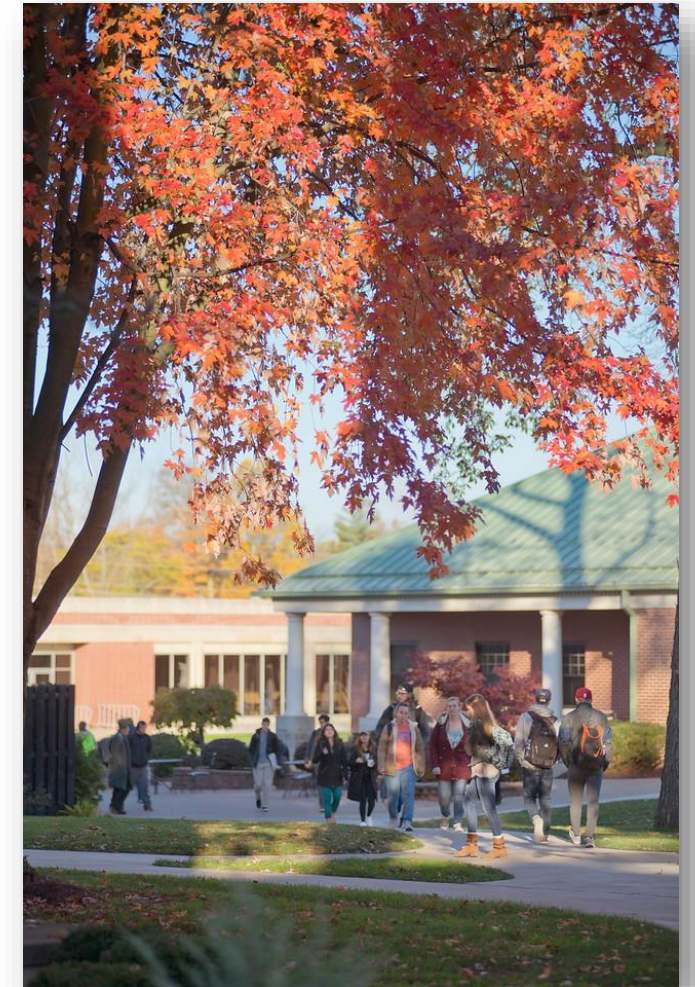
