Services Offered

Diagnosis and treatment of minor/acute injuries and illnesses, including:
Respiratory infections, ear infections, skin conditions, burns, minor lacerations, urinary tract infections, etc.

Testing:

Strep, mononucleosis, Covid-19, urinalysis, pregnancy, and glucose

Flu immunizations
Allergy injections
Mental health screening
Referrals for additional care



Most services provided within the Campus Health Center are free to students, faculty, and staff. This excludes specialty services (Cameron Psychiatry, etc.) If a student is referred to outside services or testing, they are responsible for resulting charges. These outside services may include ER/Urgent care visits, ambulance transport, prescriptions, blood tests, x-rays, etc.
